## More Light in Scottish Rite Masonry

#### HOW CAN I LEARN MORE ABOUT SCOTTISH RITE MASONRY?

My Brothers, there are many ways. Let me list some of them.

First, there is the Master Craftsman series of correspondence courses. Brother James McCallion has the information on these courses and also conducts seminars monthly.

Secondly, for those of you that would like to see all 29 degrees done in full costume and on a stage complete with excellent props, there is the annual presentation at the Valley of Guthrie, Oklahoma. It is a Friday, Saturday and Sunday presentation that is an excellent Scottish Rite experience. It is presented every Spring in Guthrie. They have lodging facilities in their building on a first come basis. There is no charge for the degrees if you are a Scottish Rite Mason. The Spring classes in 2016 are April 1, 2 and 3. Travel would be on Thursday, March 31 and return on Sunday, April 3. I have attended their degrees twice and plan on going again in 2016.

Thirdly, there is the Academy of Reflection which deals with Masonic information through a peaceful meditation environment. We have one of the only chapters outside of Guthrie, OK here in our Valley. Contact James Cervantes for information on this unique and interesting experience.

Fourth is the College of the Consistory. This is thru the Valley of Guthrie and their web site has information. It also is a correspondence course and goes deeply into each Scottish Rite degree.

So, you see my Brothers, there are many ways to add to your Scottish Rite knowledge and experience. It is up to you to allocate and prioritize your time so you can take advantage of these opportunities.
